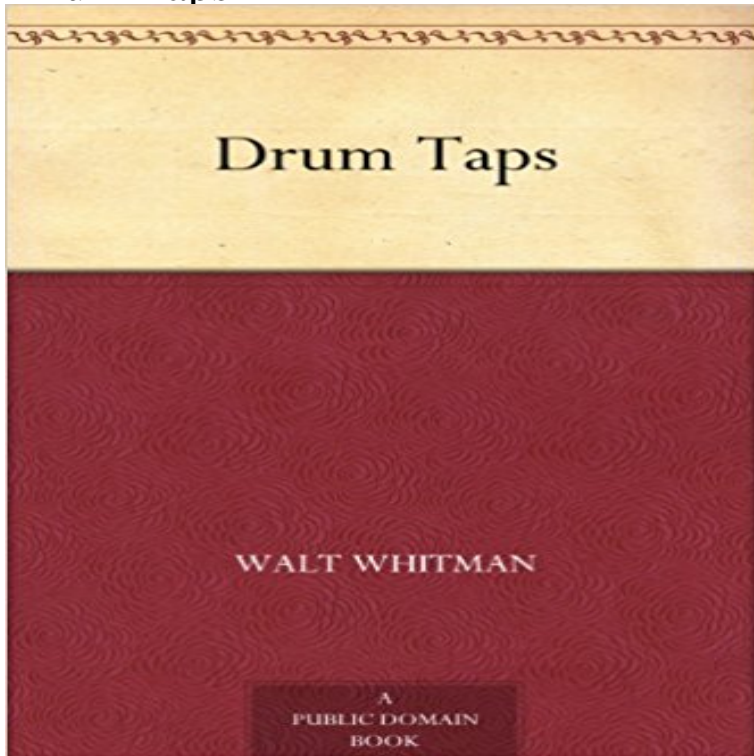


Drum Taps
