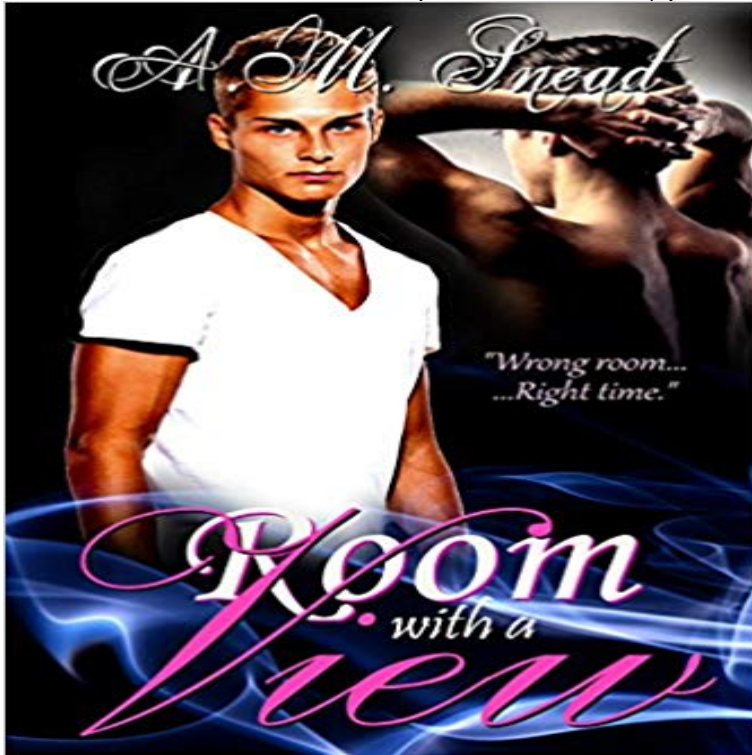


Room With A View (a short story)
