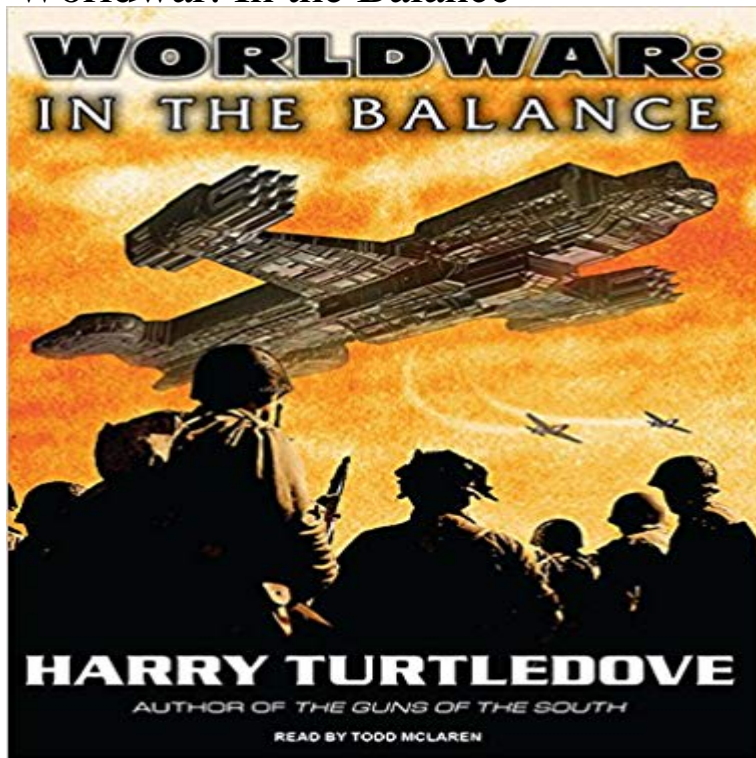


Worldwar: In the Balance
