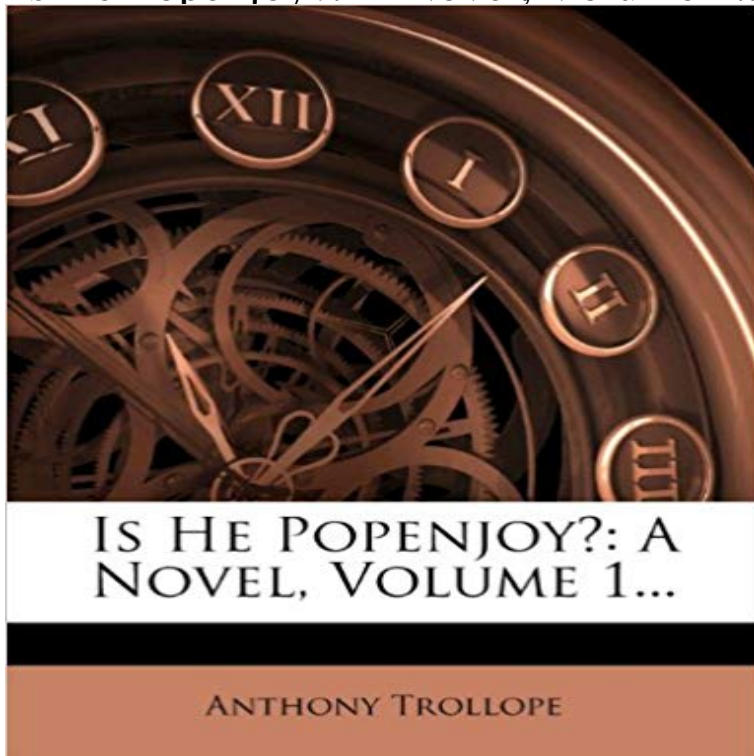


Is He Popenjoy?: A Novel, Volume 1...
