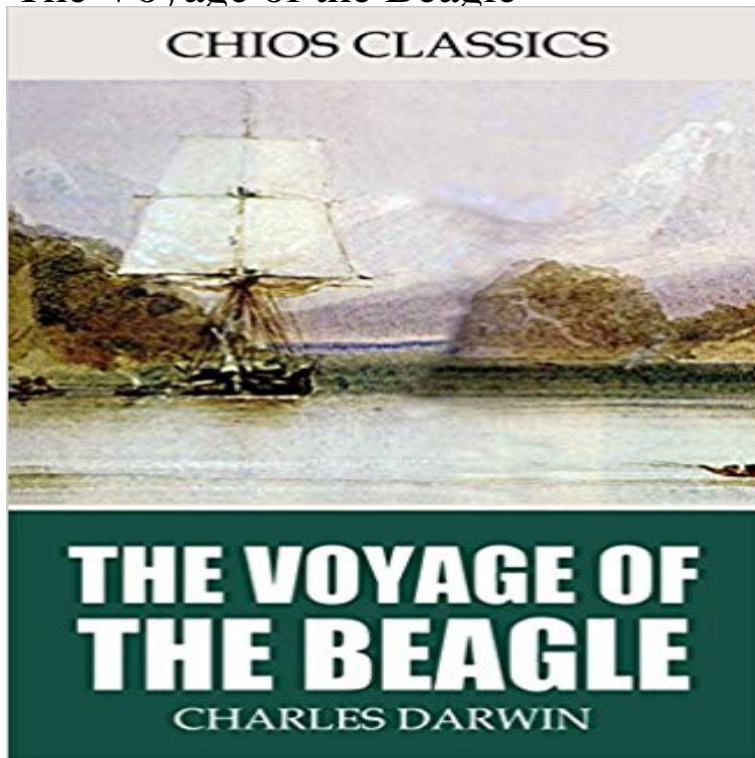


## The Voyage of the Beagle
