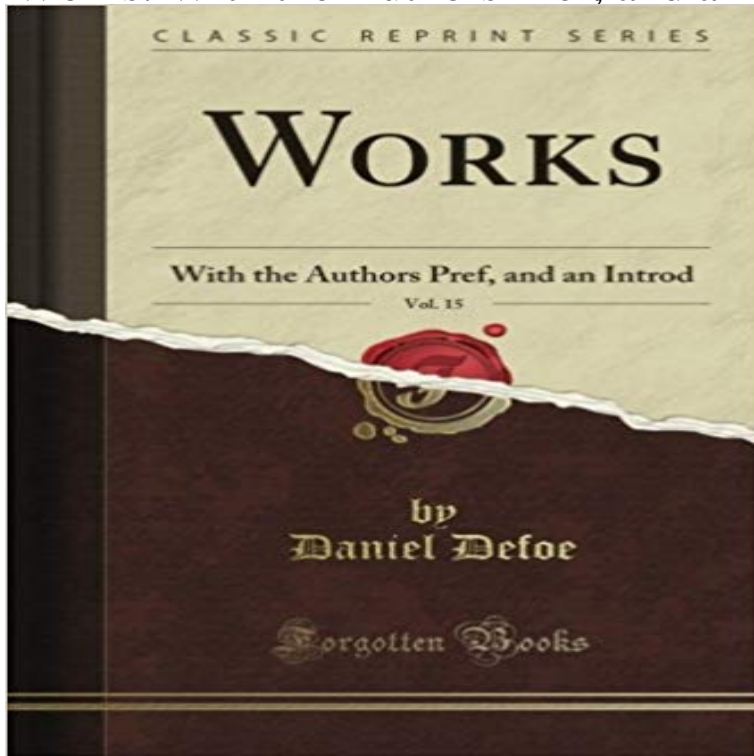

subject which we know, from A Journal of
the Plague Year, greatly interested him;
and portions of the book deal with
incidents mentioned in the better known
Journal. Besides, as Mr. Aitken has shown,
Due Preparations for the Plague is full of
Defoe smannerisms, both in vocabulary
and in nar Iative method. Neither or is an
instance of the former; the use of dialogue
in the second part, of the latter. There
seems to be no good reason for doubting
Defoe sauthorship. It is commonly said that
Defoe wrote Due Preparations for the
Plague for the same purpose as A Journal
of the Plague Year, namely to rouse people
to take precautions against the plague
