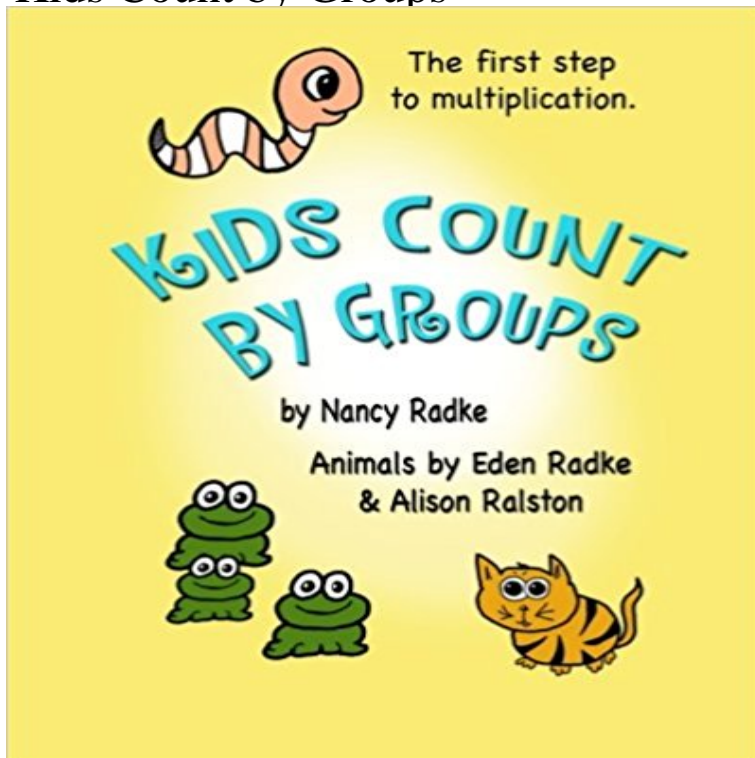


## Kids Count by Groups
