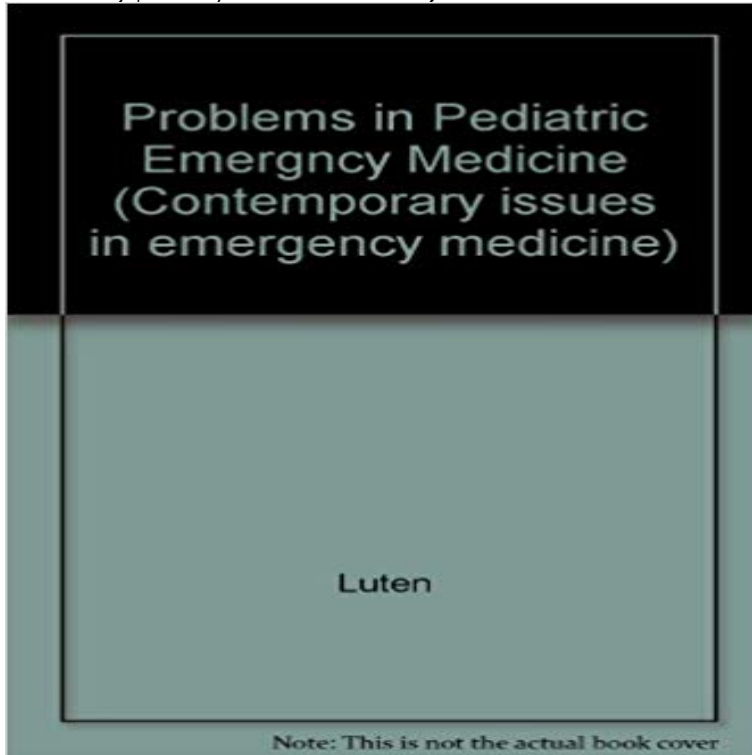


Problems in Pediatric Emergency Medicine (Contemporary Issues in Emergency Medicine)



This addresses clinical problems related to the care of the paediatric patient in the emergency situation. It concentrates on the presenting symptoms of many common diseases accounting for the majority of morbidity and mortality in children and takes a problem-oriented practical approach for these common disease entities. The text is divided in three sections: general problems related to emergency medicine, traumatic emergencies, and medical emergencies. It also provides existing knowledge and experience within emergency medicine and paediatrics for primary care providers of children.
