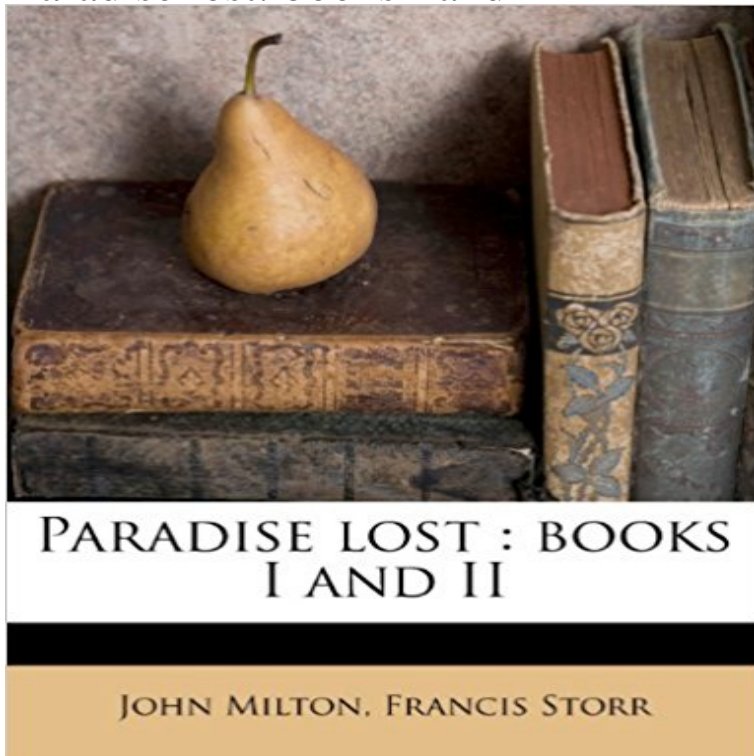


Paradise lost: books I and II
