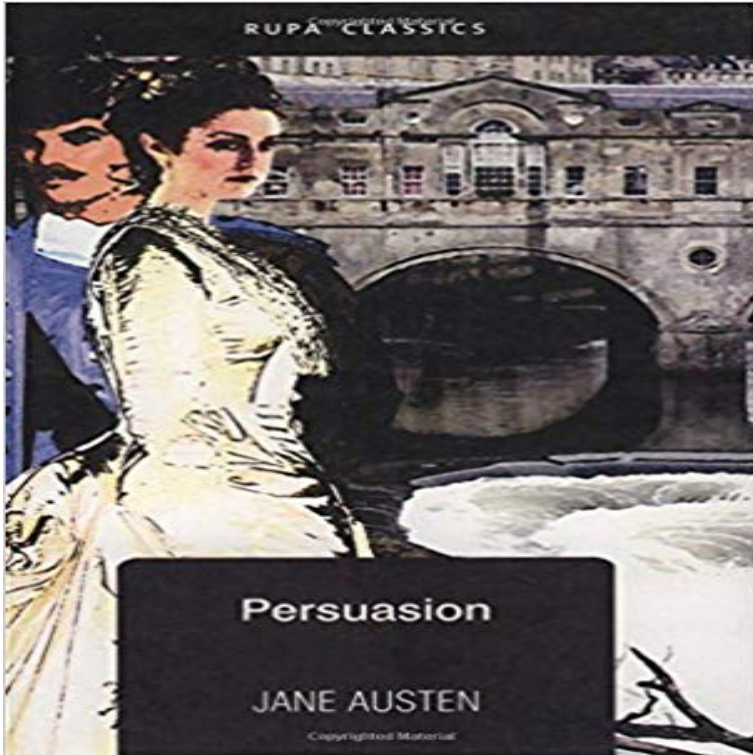


Persuasion
