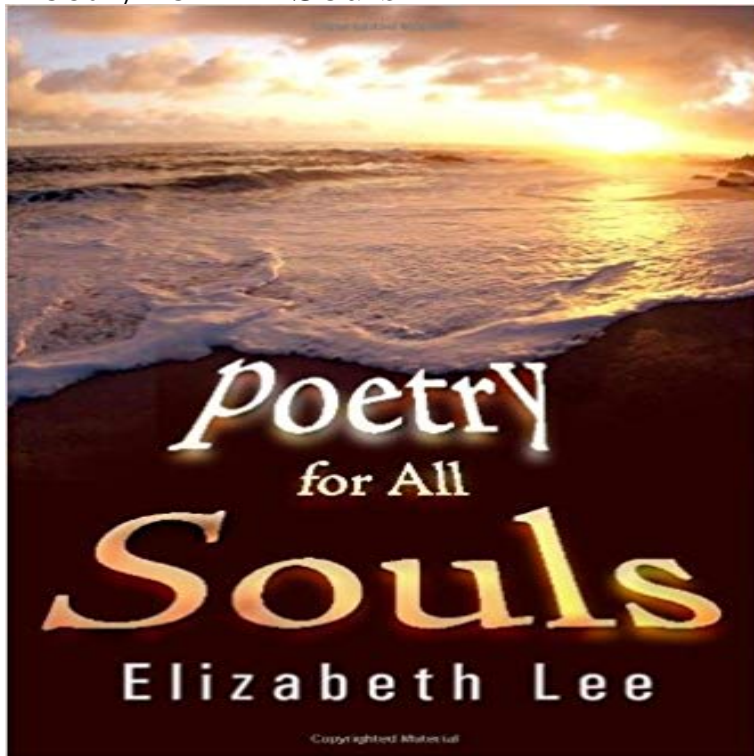


## Poetry for All Souls
