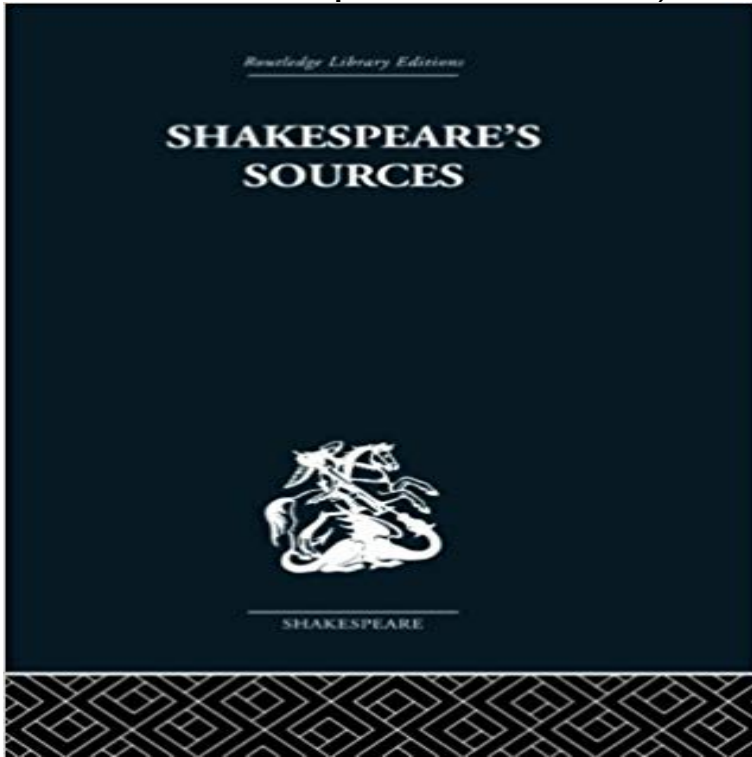


Shakespeares Sources: Comedies and Tragedies (Routledge Library Editions: Shakespeare: Comedies)
