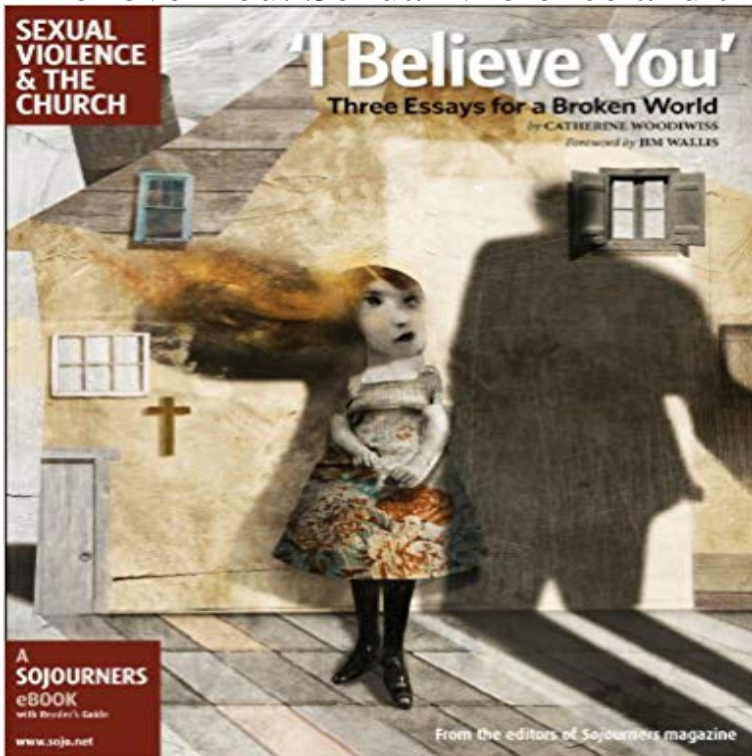


## I Believe You: Sexual Violence and the Church
