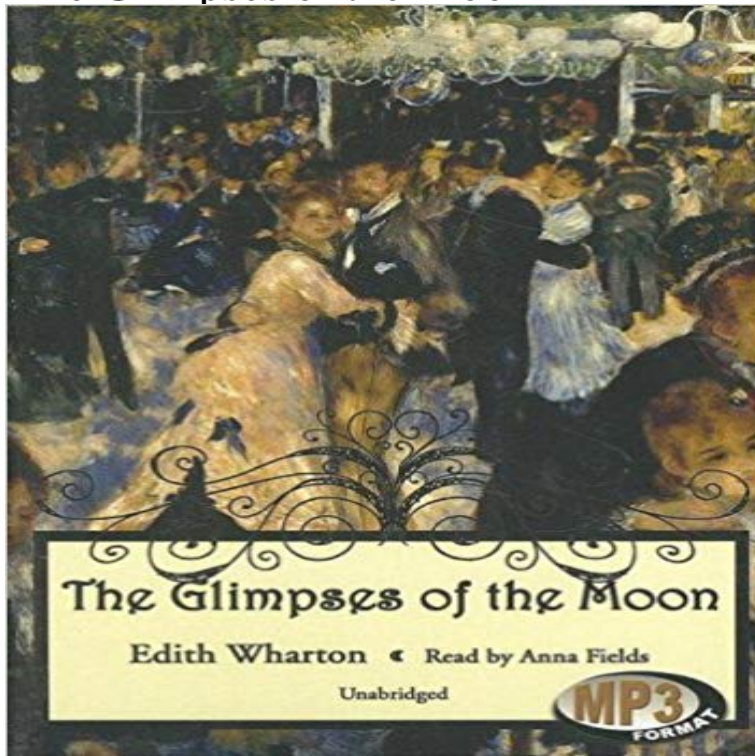


The Glimpses of the Moon
