
The Oresteia: Agamemnon, Choephori, Eumenides



The Oresteia is a trilogy of Greek tragedies written by Aeschylus which concerns the end of the curse on the House of Atreus. When originally performed it was accompanied by Proteus, a satyr play that would have been performed following the trilogy. The term Oresteia originally probably referred to all four plays, but today is generally used to designate only the surviving trilogy.
