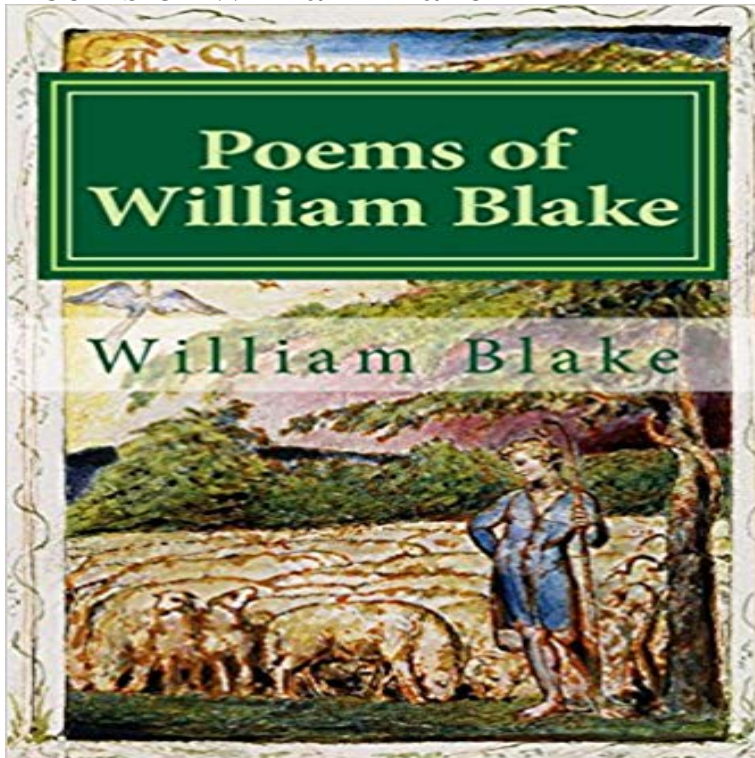


Poems of William Blake
