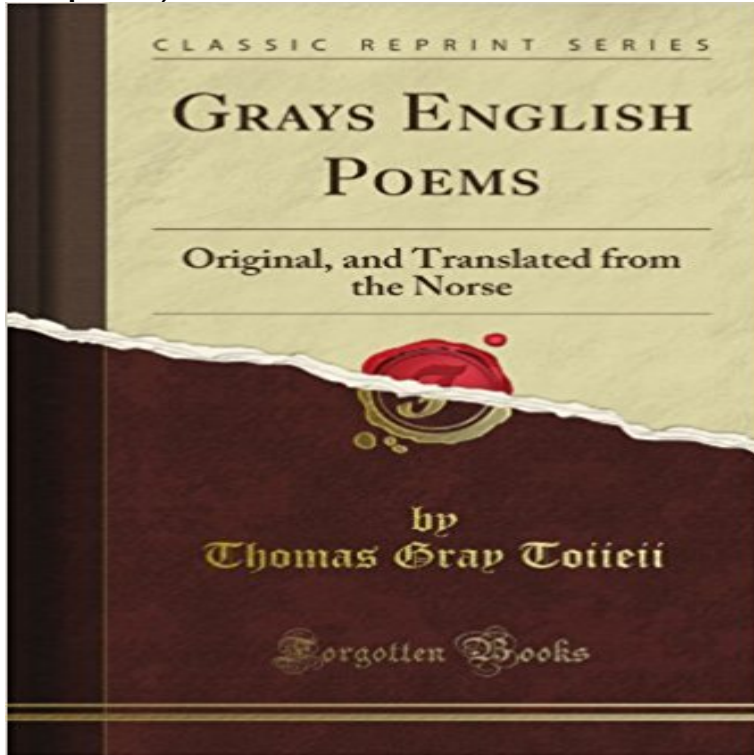


Grays English Poems: Original, and Translated from the Norse (Classic Reprint)
