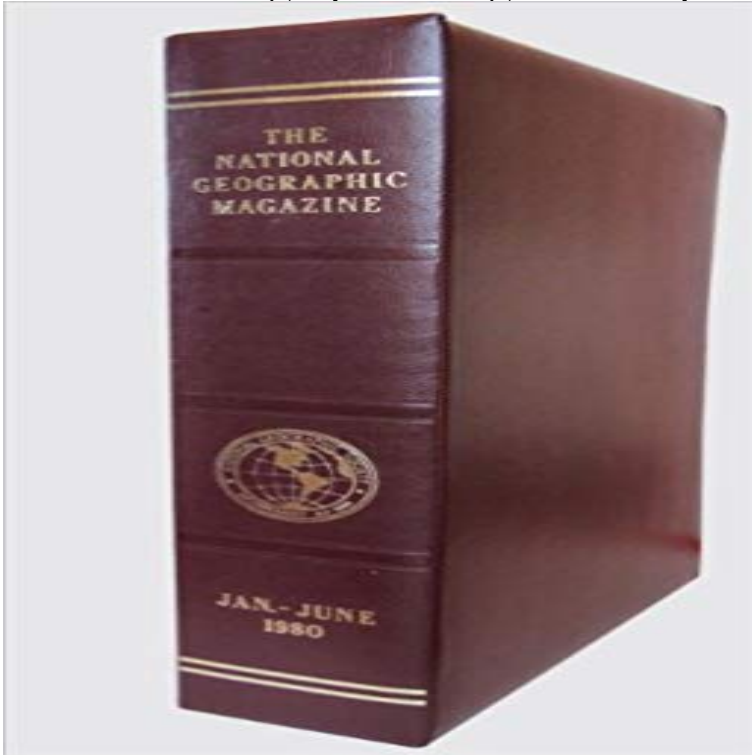


## National Geographic Magazine Slipcase: Jan.-June, 1980 (157, Vols 1-6)



The National Geographic Society issued slipcases hold 6 monthly issues of National Geographic Magazine and preserve them within richly embossed, elegantly bound sleeves. Each slipcase is padded and bound in Burgundy leatherette with a gold foil-stamped and raised shelf-end embossed with title, the societys insignia, and date of the issues to be contained. This case is designated to hold the first half of Volume 157, January-June, 1980.
