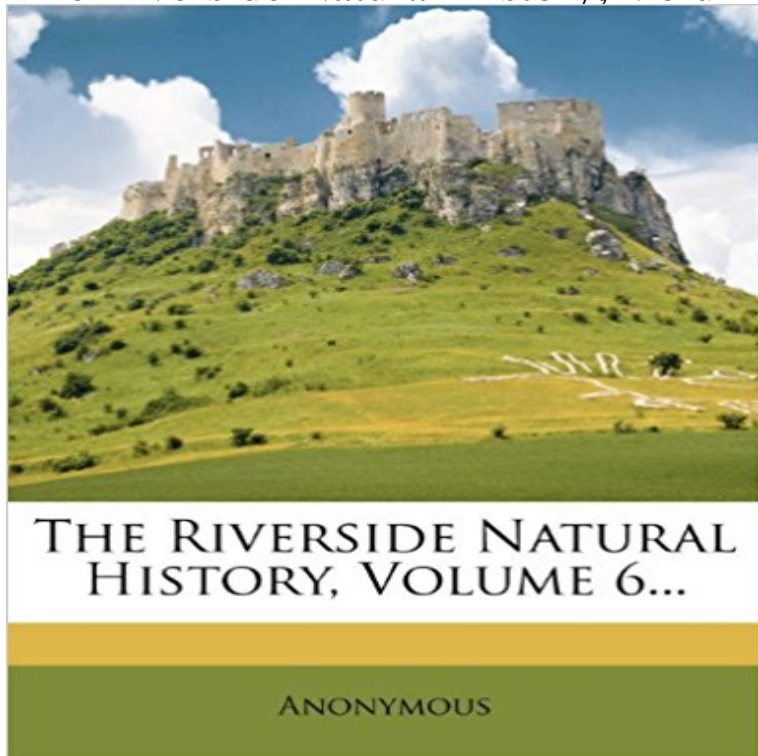


# The Riverside Natural History, Volume 6...
