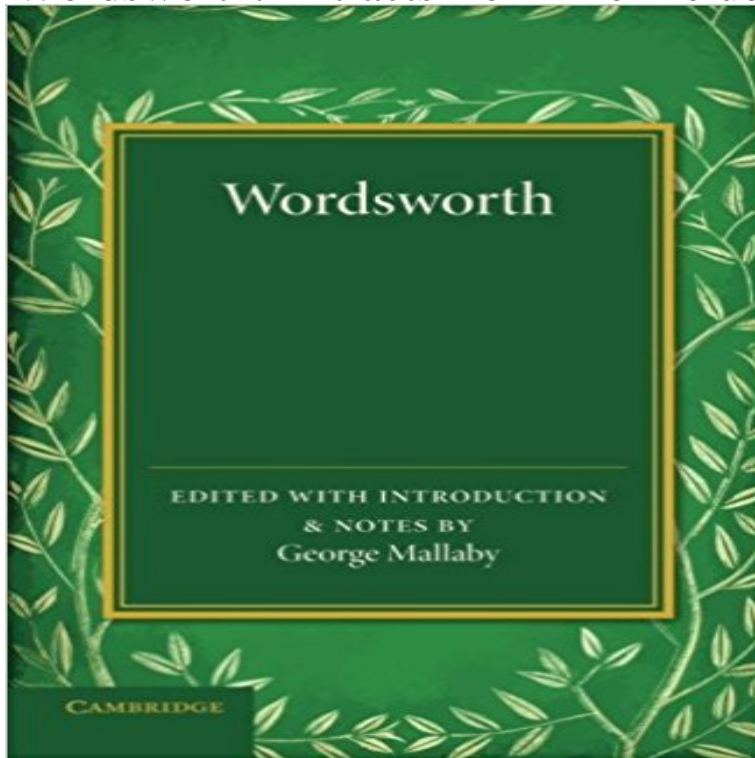


Wordsworth: Extracts from The Prelude, with Other Poems
